Janet also enlightened us as to what goes on at District Governor's Training Seminars, with and short video of one of their better guest speakers. Don't we wish all of our Guest Speakers were as entertaining??

She gave Marcus and Ian some contacts names to help us obtain grants from the compulsory Community Funds from Poker machines and encouraged us to return this money to the community through Rotary projects.
