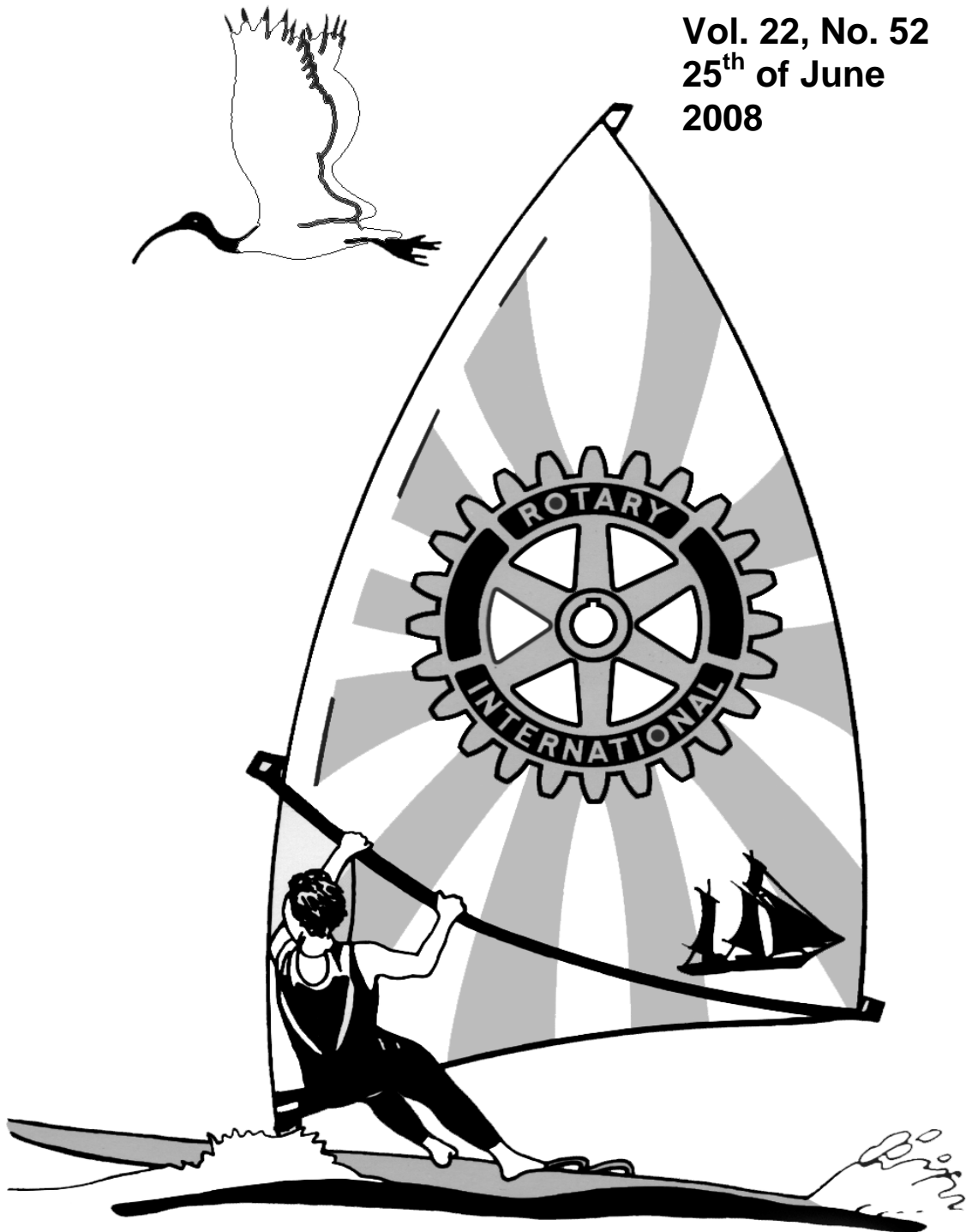

WE MAINTAINED ALL OUR ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS FROM PREVIOUS YEARS AND EMBARKED ON SOME SUCCESSFUL NEW ENDEAVOURS. LET ME NOW OUTLINE THE CLUB'S YEAR.

MEMBERSHIP

THERE WERE 16 MEMBERS IN THE CLUB AT THE START OF THE YEAR AND 7 NEW MEMBERS WERE INDUCTED DURING THE YEAR. TWO MEMBERS HAVE RESIGNED AND WE FINISHED THE YEAR WITH 21 MEMBERS. A VERY PLEASING RESULT.

CLUB ORGANISATION

IN ACCORDANCE WITH ROTARY INTERNATIONAL'S DIRECTIVES, WE CHANGED OUR BYLAWS THIS YEAR, TO ACCOMMODATE A NEW STRUCTURE OF COMMITTEES. THE SYSTEM WAS ADOPTED WITHOUT DIFFICULTY AND WORKS WELL.

EXCHANGE

THIS YEAR THE CLUB, IN CONJUNCTION WITH WONTHAGGI , PROVIDED SUPPORT FOR ASHLIE GRASA, AN INCOMING STUDENT FROM USA AND FOR ALLANA SMITH WHO SPENT A YEAR IN JAPAN . A SPECIAL THANKS TO THE FAMILIES WHO HOSTED ASHLIE DURING HER STAY.

THIS YEAR THE CLUB ALSO SUPPORTED A WEEK'S VISIT BY A GROUP EXCHANGE TEAM FROM TAMIL INDIA. THIS WAS A VERY PLEASANT EXPERIENCE FOR MEMBERS WHO WILL LONG REMEMBER THESE VISITORS.

CLUB IMPROVEMENTS

DURING THE YEAR THE CLUB PURCHASED A CAMERA, A COPIER AND A PROJECTOR TO FACILITATE THE PRODUCTION OF CLUB MATERIALS AND PRESENTATION OF COMPUTER DISPLAYS. THE CLUB WAS VERY FORTUNATE TO RECEIVE AN ALMOST NEW TRAILER WHEN THE LOCAL COAST ACTION GROUP CLOSED DOWN.

SPECIAL EVENTS

MUSICAL EVENING IN 'THE GLADE'... THIS EVENT WAS HELD IN JANUARY AND IT WAS MOST SUCCESSFUL. IT IS NOT A FUND RAISING EVENT BUT RATHER A FREE EVENING OF MUSICAL ENTERTAINMENT FOR THE COMMUNITY TO THANK THEM FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF ROTARY. MORE THAN 600 PEOPLE ENJOYED THE MUSIC IN THE GLADE.

OUR DINNER AUCTION WAS HELD ONCE AGAIN THIS YEAR AND IT WAS A VERY SUCCESSFUL EVENING ENJOYED BY ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY GUESTS AND RAISED A SURPLUS OF \$ 14200. MY THANKS TO JUDY ROBERTSON AND BRUCE MITCHELL FOR HELPING US ACHIEVE THIS SUCCESS. I WOULD ALSO LIKE TO

EXPRESS ROTARY'S APPRECIATION OF THE MARVELLOUS SUPPORT PROVIDED BY OUR DONORS AND SPONSORS.

BOAT RAFFLE: THE CLUB CONDUCTED THE ANNUAL RAFFLE OF A BOAT AND BICYCLE. THANKS TO OUR MANY TICKET SELLERS AND BOAT HANDLERS , ALL 6000 TICKETS WERE SOLD AND A PROFIT OF MORE THAN \$7000 EARNED. SPECIAL THANKS ALSO TO TIM EDNEY AND YAMAHA FOR THEIR GENEROUS SPONSORSHIP.

MARKETS: DURING THE YEAR WE CONTINUED WITH OUR CRAFT MARKETS ON THREE HOLIDAY WEEKENDS AND IN ADDITION A SATURDAY ONLY MARKET IN JANUARY AND A TRASH AND TREASURE SATURDAY IN JUNE. THESE MARKETS WERE VERY SUCCESSFUL AND THEY WERE WELL ORGANISED AND MANAGED BY KEN FISHER THIS YEAR OUR MARKETS AND BBQ's RAISED OVER \$8000. WE ASSIST OTHER COMMUNITY GROUPS TO RAISE FUNDS BY ALLOWING THEM TO OPERATE SOME OF THE MARKET SAUSAGE SIZZLES. WE CONTINUED OUR SUPPORT OF THE JAZZ FESTIVAL THIS YEAR BY AGAIN PROVIDING \$600 FOR PRIZES AND MARSHALLS FOR THE PARADE. THE PARADE IS NOW NAMED THE INVERLOCH ROTARY JAZZ FESTIVAL STREET PARADE IN RECOGNITION OF OUR LONG STANDING SUPPORT OF THE PARADE.

FELLOWSHIP

IN JANUARY, WE HEADED OFF FOR OUR ANNUAL NIGHT AT THE CRANBOURNE TROTS IN THE COMPANY OF OUR FRIENDS FROM WONTHAGGI ROTARY. MEMBERS AND PARTNERS ENJOYED BBQ'S AT ROTARY CENTENARY PARK AND AT KEN & MARGARET FISHER'S AND EXCURSIONS TO ROTARY CENTENARY HOUSE, RACV INVERLOCH AND THE BROADBEACH DEVELOPMENT DURING THE YEAR . WE WERE ALSO ENTERTAINED BY VISITING SPEAKERS AT THE HOTEL.

PROJECTS

FORESHORE: THE CLUB IS WORKING WITH THE COUNCIL TO PROVIDE MORE AMENITIES ON THE FORESHORE BETWEEN VENUS STREET AND ABBOTT STREET . A DUAL PURPOSE PATHWAY NOW RUNS TO ABBOTT STREET PASSING THROUGH THE OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED ROTARY CENTENARY PARK. THIS PARK HAS A LARGE BBQ FACILITY, PICNIC TABLES , SEATS , TOILETS AND DEVELOPMENTS IN THE NEAR FUTURE WILL INCLUDE A CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA , A VIEWING PLATFORM, BUS PARKING AND A SECOND BBQ WHEN NEEDED.

THE CLUB HAS ALSO BEEN INVOLVED IN PLANS FOR A PATHWAY FROM 'THE GLADE' TO CUTTRISS STREET WHICH SHOULD OCCUR IN THE NEAR FUTURE. THIS WILL INCLUDE A TOILET AT CUTTRISS STREET AND ACCESS TO THE HISTORICAL AREAS OF TOY'S BACKWATER AND THE SEAWALL.

OTHER PROJECTS OF THE CLUB ARE OUTDOOR FURNITURE AT SEAHAVEN AND A BBQ AT THE NEW WOODLANDS COTTAGES.

ROSE GARDENS AT THE POWLETT STREET ENTRANCE TO INVERLOCH PROVIDE A MUCH IMPROVED INTRODUCTION TO THE TOWN (ROTARY WHEELS)

HEALTH

THE FOLLOWING AREAS OF HEALTH WERE DISCUSSED BY SPEAKERS: PROSTATE CANCER, ORGAN DONATION, ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION, BOWEL CANCER. A GRANT OF \$1 000 WAS GIVEN TO THE ROYAL CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL TO PROVIDE BOOKS FOR CHILDREN WITH TYPE 1 DIABETES.

A SPECIAL PROJECT HAS BEEN DEVELOPED WITH WONTHAGGI SECONDARY COLLEGE TO PROVIDE 240, YEAR 10 PARENTS WITH A DRUG AND ALCOHOL BOOK DEVELOPED BY TRINITY GRAMMAR SCHOOL. TRINITY HAS GIVEN US THE RIGHTS TO REPRODUCE THIS FIRST RATE PUBLICATION FOR SCHOOLS. I HAVE BEEN APPROACHED BY A CLUSTER OF SCHOOLS IN THE WANGARATTA AREA FOR ITS POSSIBLE USE AND LOCAL ROTARY CLUBS ARE ALSO CONSIDERING ITS REPRODUCTION IN THEIR AREAS.

MEDICAL INFORMATION BOOKLETS

THESE BOOKLETS ARE AN INITIATIVE OF ROTARY AND RURAL AMBULANCE . AN INDIVIDUAL'S MEDICAL DETAILS AND MEDICATIONS ARE RECORDED IN THE BOOK WHICH CAN ADHERE TO THE FRIDGE AND IS THEN AVAILABLE FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES. THE CLUB HAS PURCHASED AND DISTRIBUTED 1 000 OF THESE BOOKLETS FOR FREE TO MEMBERS OF OUR COMMUNITY. WE HAVE ALSO HAD ANOTHER 500 BOOKS SPONSORED BY THE WONTHAGGI WORKMEN'S CLUB.

3MFM

THE CLUB HAS JOINED WITH BASS COAST SHIRE COUNCIL TO STOP THE POSSIBLE CLOSURE OF COMMUNITY RADIO STATION 3MFM . THE STATION HAS CRIPPLING DEBTS OF APPROX. \$40 000. ROTARY AND THE COUNCIL WILL LEAD A PUBLIC APPEAL FOR FUNDS TO AVOID THE STATION'S CLOSURE.

PROMOTION

EARLY IN THE YEAR, THE PROMOTION COMMITTEE DECIDED THAT THE CLUB NEEDED AN INFORMATION BROCHURE PROVIDING DETAILS ABOUT ROTARY AND IN PARTICULAR THE ROTARY CLUB OF INVERLOCH. THE BROCHURE HAS BEEN VERY SUCCESSFUL IN INFORMING THE PUBLIC AND OUR COMMUNITY OF THE CLUB'S PROGRAMS AND ACHIEVEMENTS. A NEW EDITION OF THE BROCHURE IS AVAILABLE TONIGHT.
