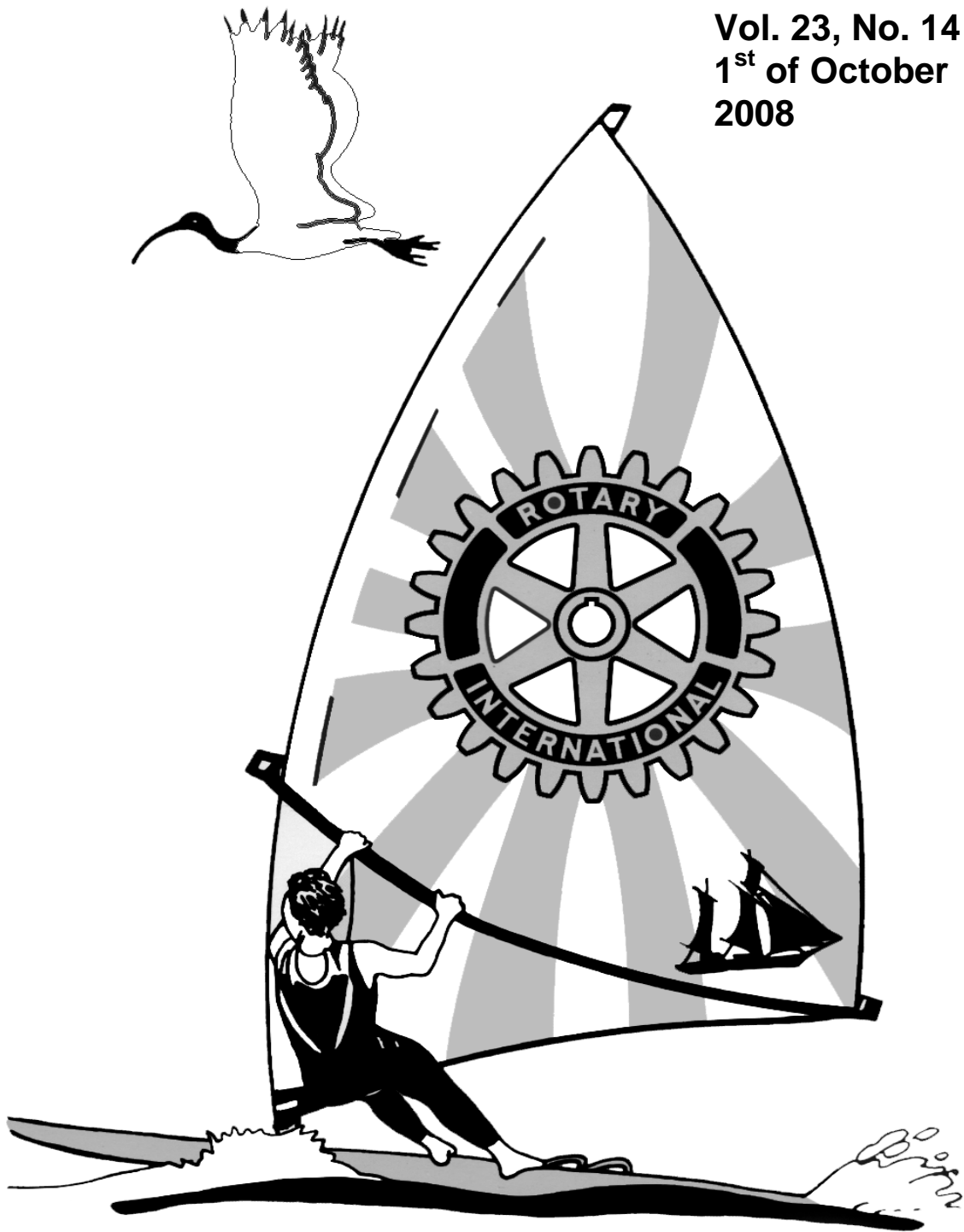

LAST MEETING: **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> of September 2008**

Agenda: Representatives of **Mitsui & Co (Australia)** Matthew Croome, Kerry Yu and Denise Murrell gave a presentation on their "**Bald Hills Wind Farm**" project located between Tarwin Lower and Walkerville, not far at all from Ken and Margaret Fisher's place.

Mitsui is a 90 year old company operating in 68 countries and employing about 42,000 staff. They have interests in Electricity Generation (own 30% of Loy Yang) both coal and gas fired (Kwinana 300 Megawatt plant south of Perth WA). They are currently investing in green generation of power including Hydro, Solar and Biomass. Bald Hills is their 5<sup>th</sup> wind powered project. They are also involved in Coal and other mineral mining and export, meat, grain and dairy produce exports, also machinery production.

Mitsui bought 100% of Wind Power Australia to be owners of the Bald Hills project. It will consist of 52 “two-megawatt” turbines in three groups. At a measured long term average wind speed of 8 metres per second they expect to generate 335 gigawatt-hours of renewable power per year. This is enough to power 62,000 homes and avoids the production of 335,000 tons of CO2 per year if generated by coal. (Equivalent to taking 77,000 motor cars off the road or the planting of 500,000 trees).

If all environmental, cultural and heritage effects studies pass as OK and the ground and soil conditions have been studied and surveyed, they will then offer lease contracts to local land-owners, sign construction and supply contracts and construction will start. Local companies and expertise will be used if available. Towers will be built in Australia but the Turbine nacelles and blades will most likely come from Europe.

Timeline has main contracts in place by Dec 2008, finance in place by April 2009 and to begin construction June 2009. Estimated total cost is over \$300 million.
