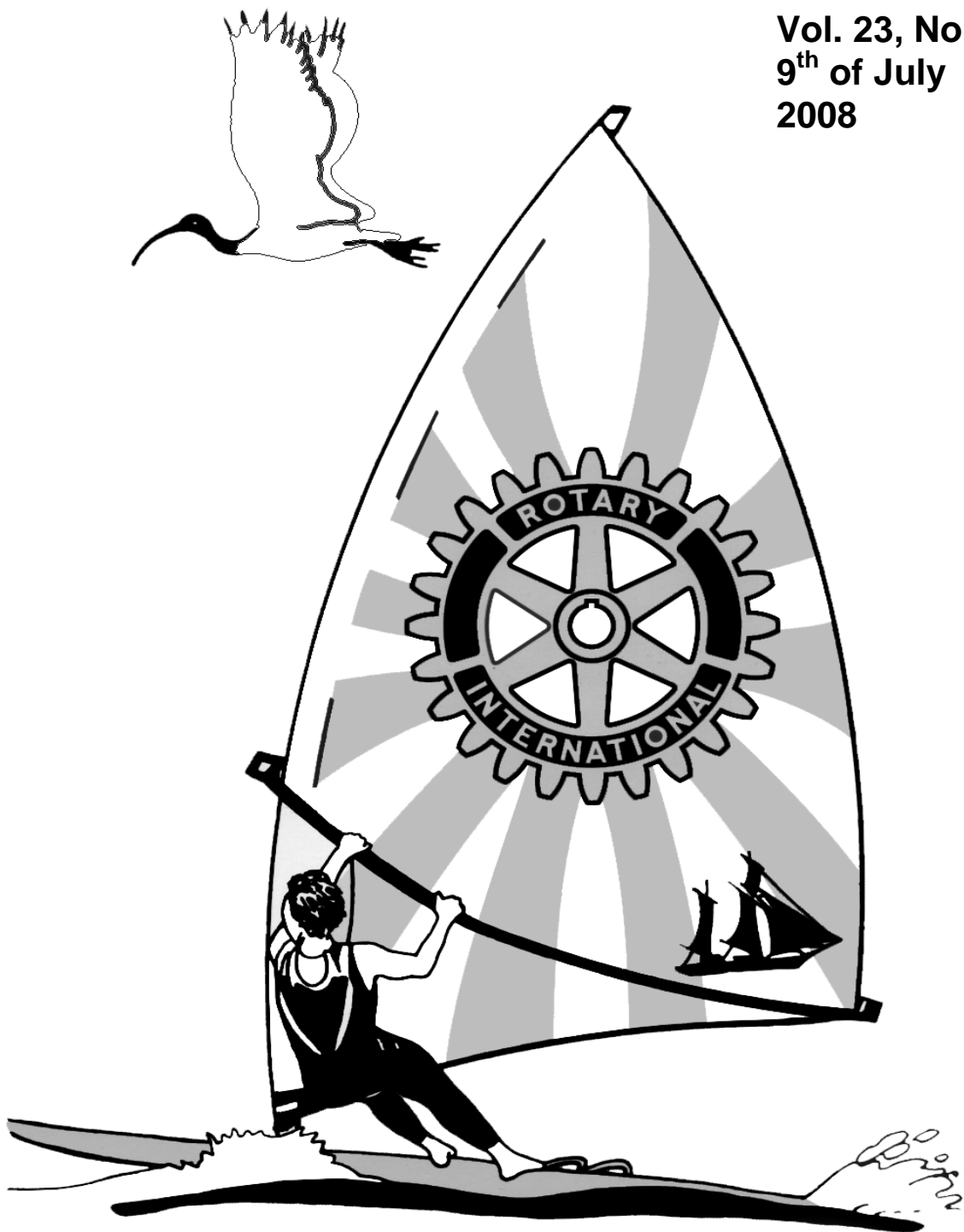

NEW DVD WILL HELP NEW AND EMERGING COMMUNITIES INTO RADIO BROADCASTING

A DVD to help new and emerging communities becoming involved in community radio was launched last night.

Minister Assisting the Premier on Multicultural Affairs James Merlino launched the DVD at the Immigration Museum as part of Refugee Week (June 15-21).

“This landmark DVD will provide our new and emerging communities with an opportunity to connect with their communities via radio,” Mr Merlino said.

“The Brumby Government is proud to support this DVD as part of our continuing commitment to promote diversity and social inclusion and to encourage community communication and participation.”

The DVD titled, *Becoming a Community Radio Broadcaster - A Guide For Emerging Communities*, has been produced by 3ZZZ, Melbourne’s multicultural community radio station.

The DVD provides an insight into the workings of community ethnic radio and examines pathways for aspiring broadcasters.

The Brumby Government provided funding to support the project through the Victorian Multicultural Commission’s Community Grants Program.

Ms. Judith Sanda, a participant in the DVD, spoke of the benefits of radio broadcast training.

“This will give me the chance to learn useful skills whilst at the same time doing something that I love,” Ms Sanda said.

“Being involved in radio gives me a chance to relate to my community here.”

The DVD highlights the challenges and rewards of becoming a community broadcaster and provides insights, histories and personal stories from both experienced and new broadcasters.

The DVD will be provided to public libraries across Victoria.
