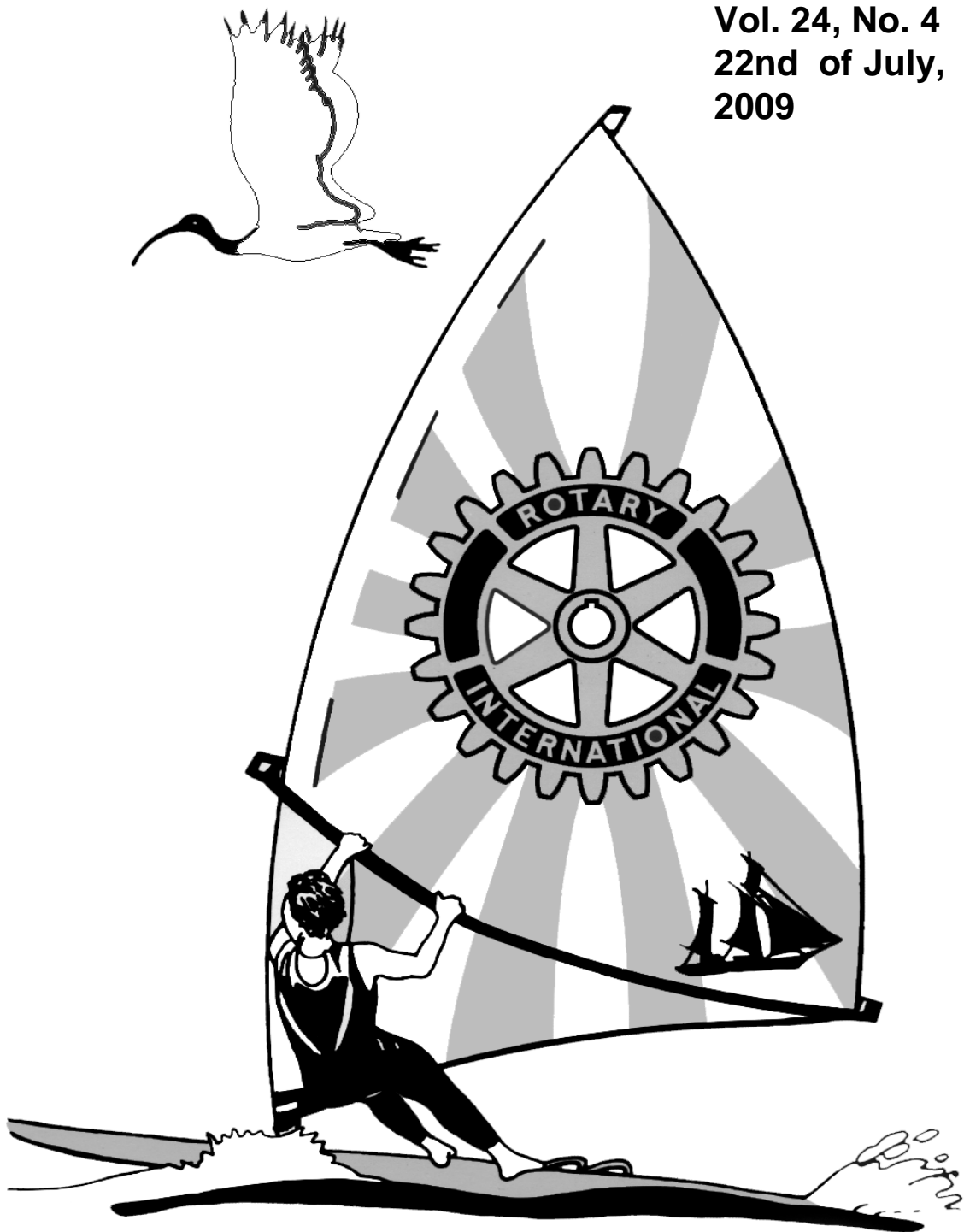

#### **Inverloch Community Hub**

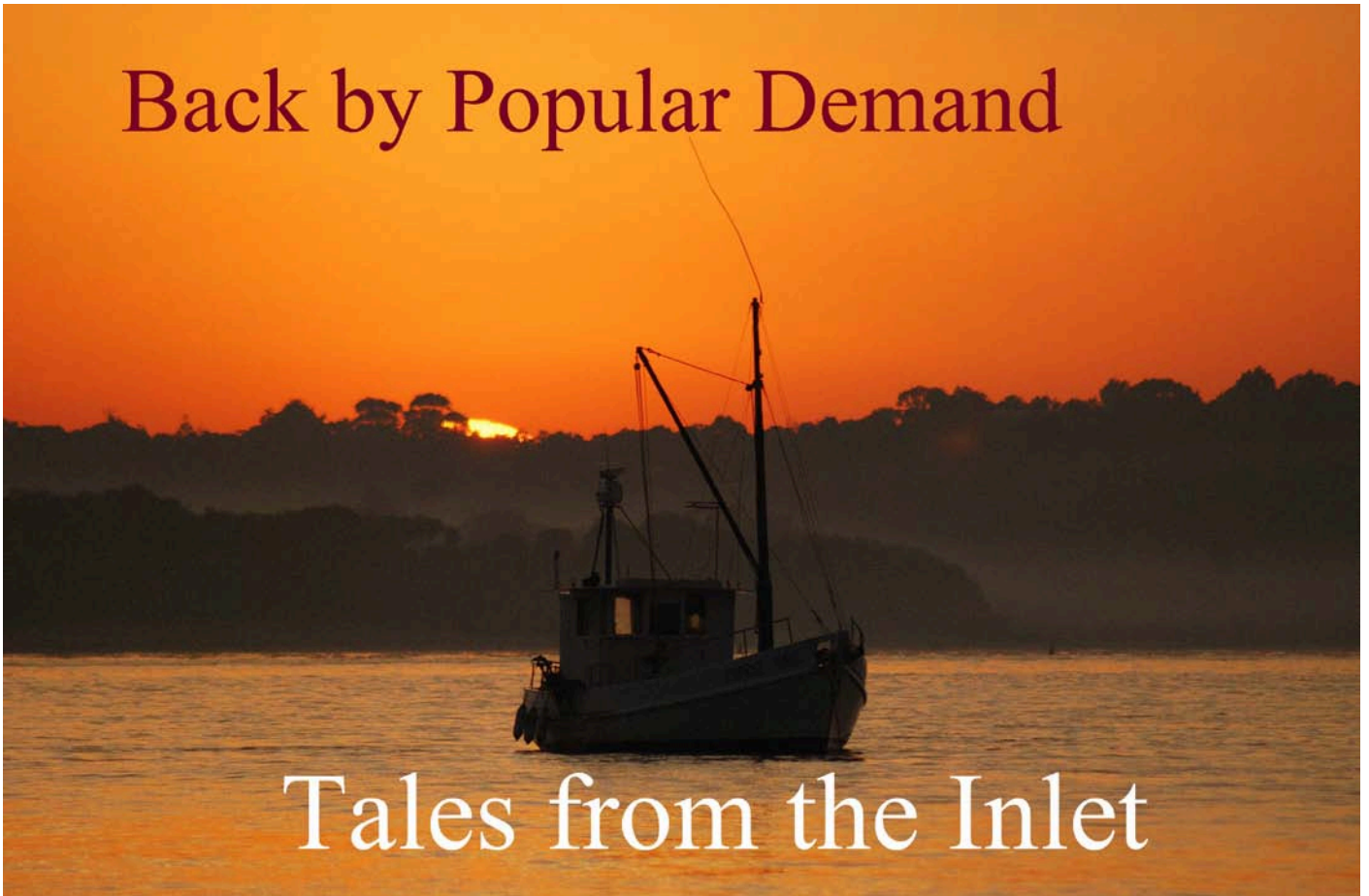
Rotarians Ken Fisher and Ian Monro attended a recent meeting with BCSC to emphasize that Rotary did not want any more of the remaining outdoor area lost to exotic landscape designs, as there would then be not enough room to hold our Craft markets. They suggested firmly that no more than 20% of the remaining outdoor area be garden and the rest be level turf / lawn. Good support was forthcoming from Lions and the RSL club. Council officers seemed this time to accept the local point of view.

They may also be in favour of closing off Reilly Street from Abeckett St to the start of the Food Works carpark as a temporary pedestrian MALL on Saturday of any Community event such as our Markets, Billy Cart Derby, Jazz Festival etc.
