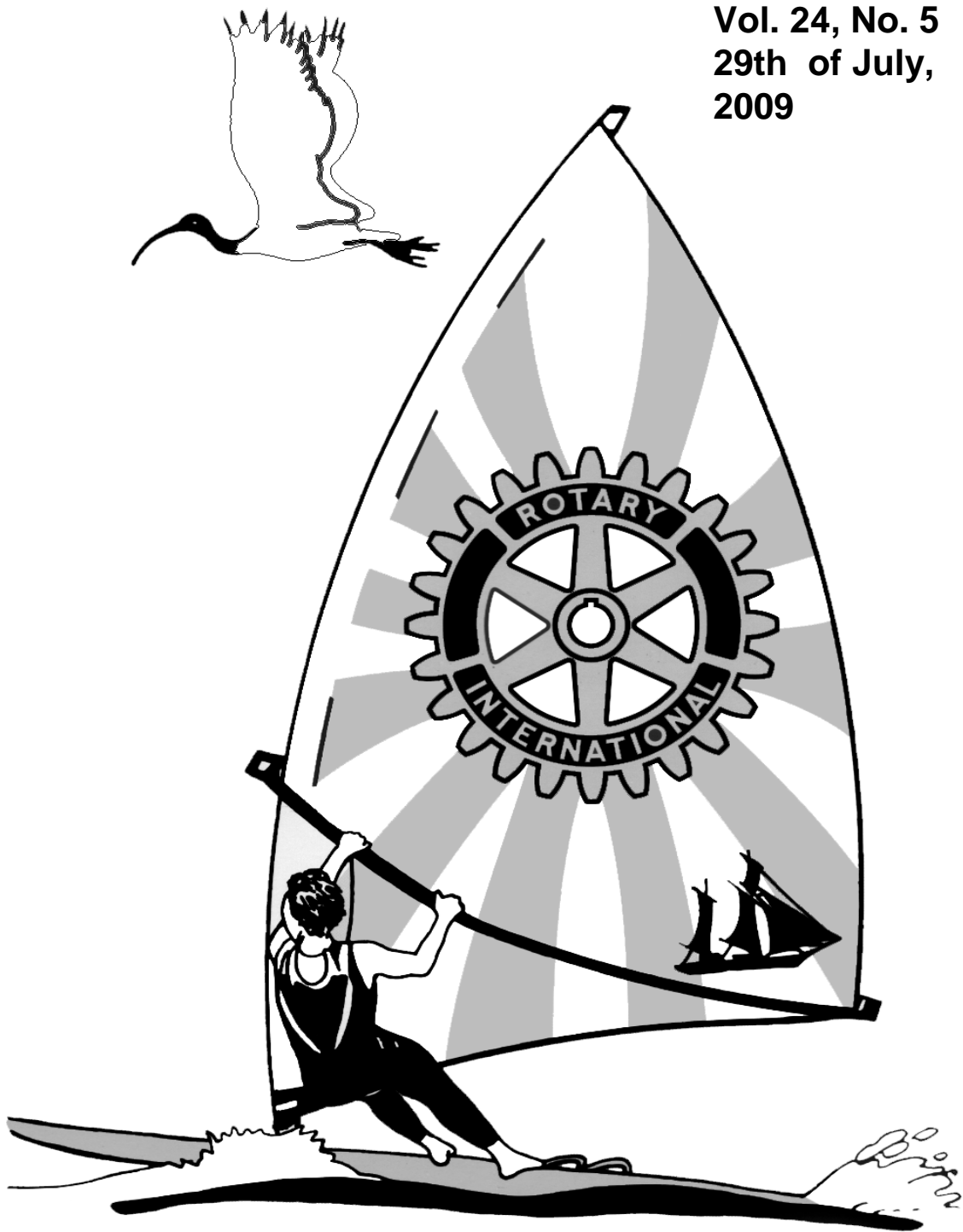

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## Last Meeting: Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> of July, 2009

### Agenda:

Presentation by Rachel Tobias of "Anglicare Gippsland"



Rachel is a team leader in Anglicare's Financial services area and is based in Leongatha. She spoke about the full range of services provided by Anglicare, including: Community Services, Financial services, Family services and Children's services.

Due to several factors including bushfires and economic downturns in the Gippsland area her job as a financial counsellor is very overloaded at the moment and 3 new staff are being added to cope. Most cases presenting are **crisis driven**, that is advice and help are not requested until eviction, repossession or bankruptcy are imminent. It becomes a rush to intervene with creditors, banks and finance companies all after money or goods. In many cases other medical and counselling services need to be obtained as people in severe financial stress can be very depressed or even suicidal about it. Anglicare has a range of interest free loans, grants and payments available that vary depending on whether the client is on centrelink benefits and if they own, are buying or are renting a home. They can also assist clients with budget plans to ensure they can live on limited income streams.

Rachel also spoke about the large number of foster care children that Anglicare must find placements for every month. They range from short term emergency placements for various family reasons such as violence, drug use, parental separation, health problems, arrests and gaol time to longer term foster care to permanent adoption or other legal permanent care orders. Rachel responded very well to the various questions from our audience and Chairman Terry Grace thanked her and presented her with a small gift.

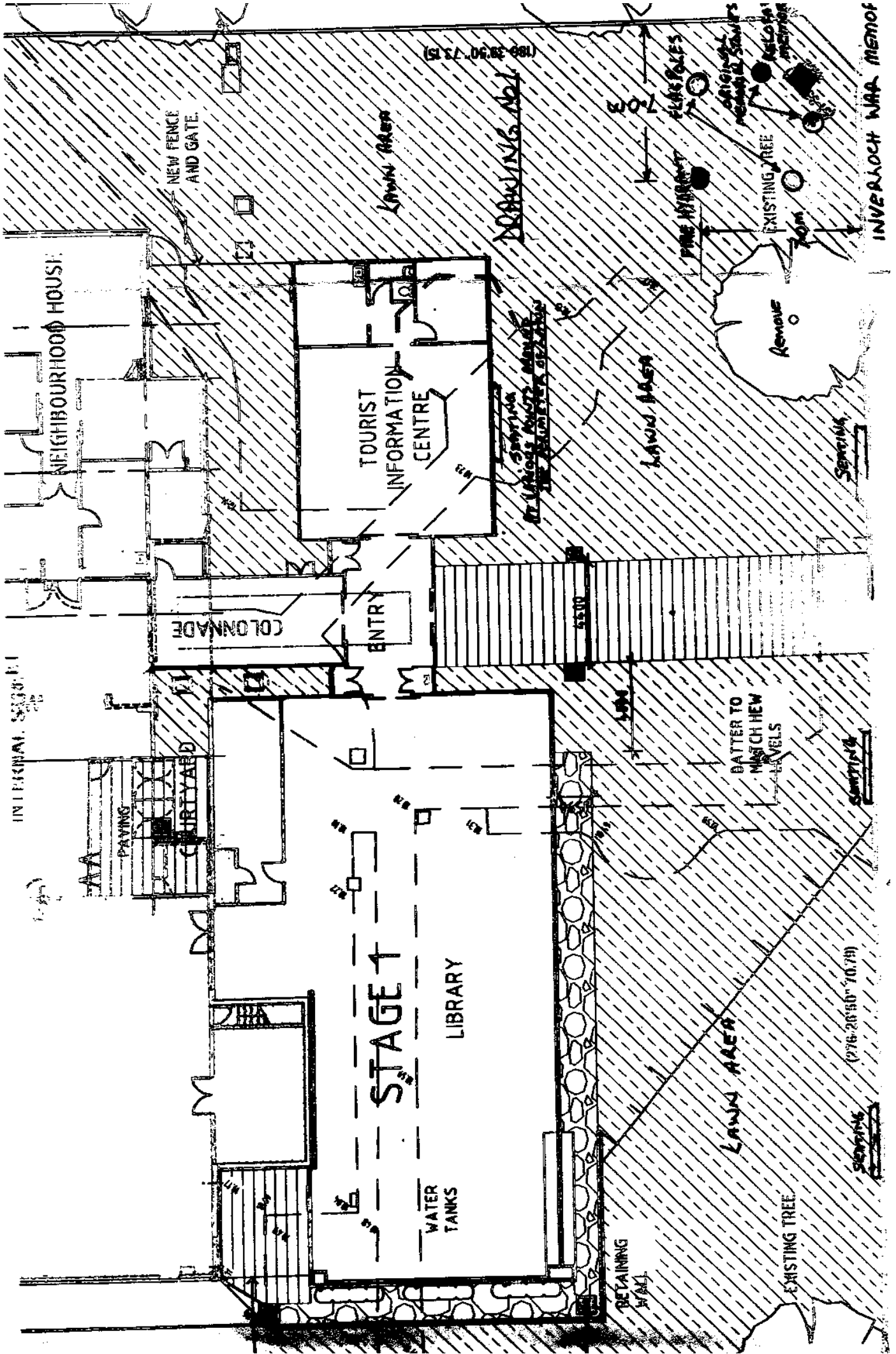
### **Inverloch Community Hub**

Rotarians Ken Fisher and Ian Monro reported on the new grounds plan for the outdoor areas (*see site map*) in front of the new library and Info centre renovations which are now basically complete and ready for operation. The area will be mostly level lawns and the RSL flagpoles and memorials will relocate closer to the corner of Reilley and A'Becket Streets. Bushes under the Rotary Clock are too tall and need to be pruned back or replaced with lower shrubs. A local historical "Time Capsule" was dug up during the site works and will be replanted and marked for posterity. Site should be ready by our September Market.
