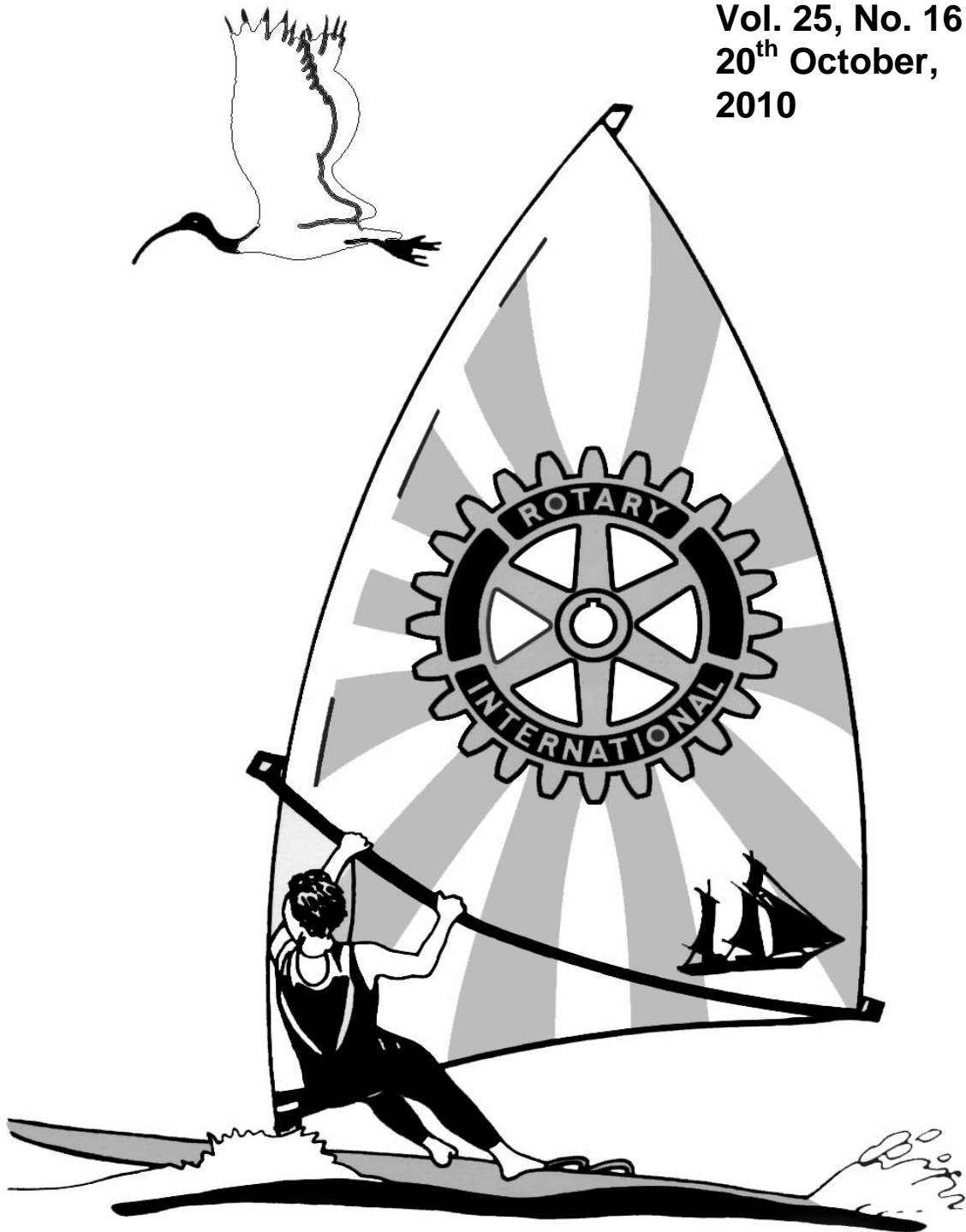

Identity theft is predicted to be the epidemic crime of this century. The Australasian Consumer Fraud Taskforce (an Australia and New Zealand joint initiative) state that 1 in every 20 Aussies will fall victim to a scam. Most scams are based on the theft of a person's identity and few realise that they have become a victim until the criminals are beyond the reach of Australian and International law. Frequently the criminals operate from countries, which deny extradition to Australia. If you know how the criminals work their scams you can take simple, effective precautions. Percy Cooper, a licensed Private Investigator, will explain how identity thieves work and tell you of the simple ways to make safe you and your family.
