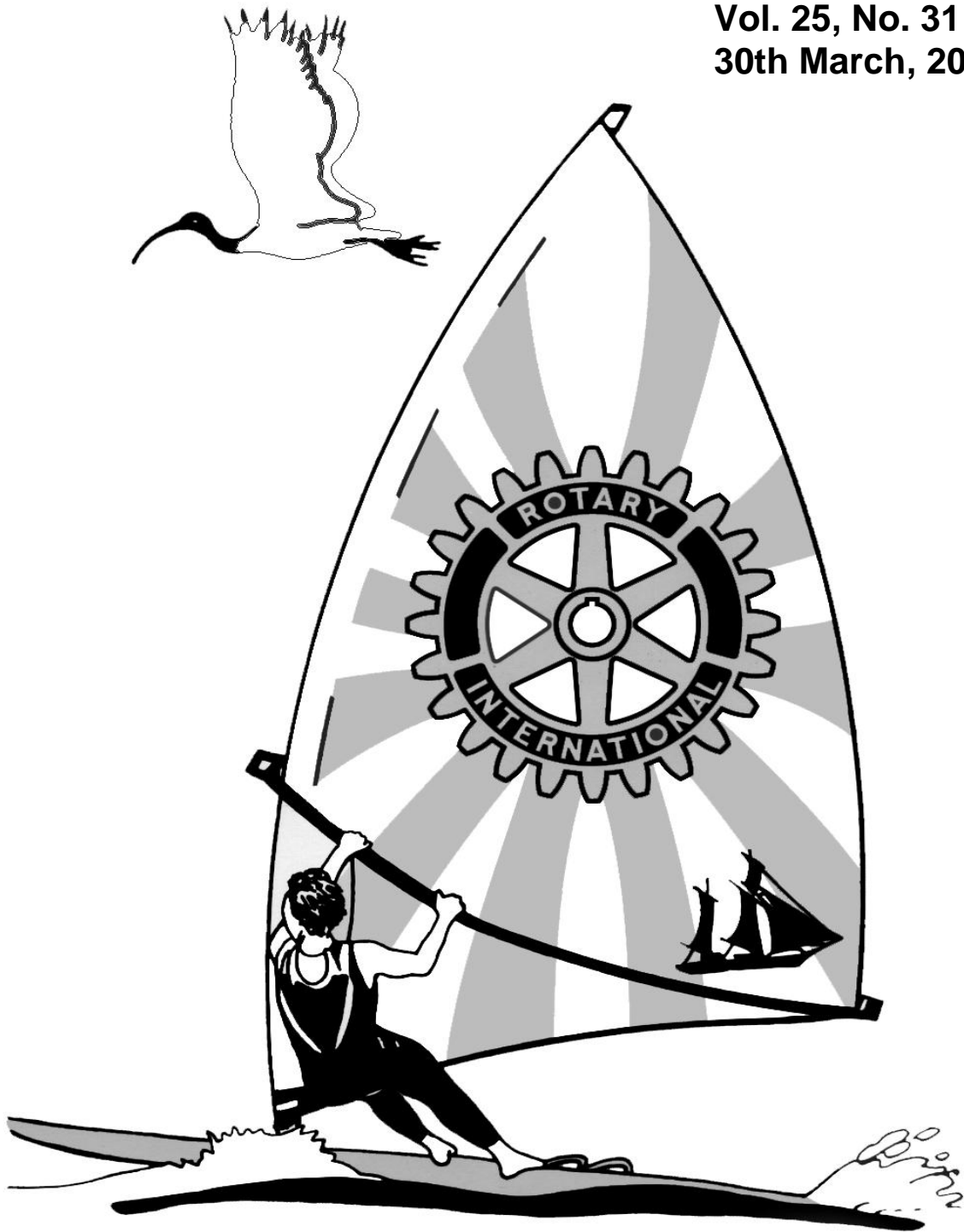

Reports:

President's Report:

As you all know Robin and I attended the 53rd District Conference at Shepparton at the week-end. The conference gave all Rotarians the chance to listen to guest speakers and interact with others and share ideas. One of the most interesting things that came out of the conference was that we as Rotarians need to move forward if Rotary is to survive.

One idea was that Rotary clubs may need to 'look back to look forward'; we need to try new things and have open minds to change. For example, explore new ways to attract new members.

One of the speakers, Michael Mc Queen, spoke about the difference between the Generations, that is The Builders (early 1900s-Mid- 1940s), The Baby Boomers (Mid 1940s-Mid1960s), Generation X (Mid 1960s-Early 1980s), Gen Y (Early 1980s-Late 1990s) and Gen Z (Late 1990s-?) and the next Gen may be XLs. The distinction between the way these groups think and act was given in the example of the Vegemite Jar: 'The Builder Gen' would scrape all vegemite out, every last drop, wash the jar and then either use jar for jam, nail and screw storage. On the other hand Gen Y would discard jar with vegemite still quite visible in jar and open a new one, or put half used jar back in cupboard and open new jar. The importance of that jar of vegemite was seen differently by two different generations ... neither right nor wrong in the way the jar was used.

The importance of this for Rotary Clubs is that to attract new members and retain them we need to challenge ourselves. We need to give ourselves the permission to move forward and change. We need to ask ourselves 'why do we do things the way we do'? We need to adapt to be able to communication with the new Generation, share ideas and work together.

Robin and I will give a talk to Rotary at a later date about attending the conference, plus Robin's ride to conference. It has only made us more excited about Rotary and the things that can be achieved by a club in the community. We are very proud to say that we belong to Inverloch Rotary and I know that we are on the right path. I thank all club members for their effort in supporting this change, I firmly believe that Inverloch Rotary will survive and grow if we let it. Thank you,
