As for District 9820, your Foundation committee will be active in promoting the Centurion Club membership where Rotarians and others can agree to give A\$100 to the Foundation (tax deductible) each year if they choose to. We will be promoting this programme throughout the year.

We will also be commencing a "Paul Harris Society" where giving of US\$1000 each year (tax deductible)entitles one to membership. Once again this giving is voluntary and can cease at any time if the participant does not wish to continue. More information regarding these programmes will be forthcoming over the coming months.

We now come to some exciting news I that, as from 1 July 2013 The Rotary Foundation "Future Vision" programme begins. This will lead to a new way of doing things in regard to grants. There will be two types of grants: District Grants and Global Grants.

Here are some of the advantages of Future Vision.

1. Simplifies the grant-making process
2. Supports Rotarian-identified needs within communities
3. Involves clubs, not just districts
4. Offers more options for scholarships
5. Uses an online application process

There is a great deal to learn about Future Vision and your committee will carry out training and information session prior to its inception.
