Information from the LAST MEETING:

Club matters:

- 1) Bowel Scan: Overall 46% increase in kits distributed; 35 in Inverloch with 1 test needing further review
- 2) Community website (inverloch.org.au): leaflet drop this week to all PO boxes; public launch within a couple of weeks
- 3) Info required re certificates gained (eg Working with children, food handling, traffic management). See Ross Wise.

Governor's Review: Tony Spring

- 1) Good meeting with the board: "Inverloch punches above its weight"
- 2) Rotary Round Up on 3mFM: really good and we need more of this in the District
- 3) Major fund raisers (markets, boat raffle) – excellent
- 4) Support for inverloch.org.au, particularly in that it is a community project and it promotes Rotary and its name / brand
- 5) Membership: 5000 less Rotarians vs a decade ago – an important challenge
- 6) Foundation: 'Future Vision' will be implemented; changes coming eg grant system
- 7) Group Study Exchanges (GSE): with Holland in 1st half 2013 – host clubs sought; consider a joint effort with other clubs
- 8) Polio Plus: remains a major challenge for Rotary which must be won
- 9) PR must be a focus for clubs: membership growth; ensure and use the fact that the community knows that money raised by Rotary WILL go to the right place
- 10) Youth Exchange: difficult for Inverloch – understood; can do a shared program; seek hosts actively; the future of YE is at risk.
- 11) Presidential Citation: look at the opportunity / criteria including Peace Through Service
- 12) Carla Spring's Project: Indian Schooling led by a friend of Tony and Carla – 'a Rotarian making a difference through Rotary'; successes achieved but much more needed; support sought after
- 13) Consider attending the Geelong Conference next year: value, interesting and fun
