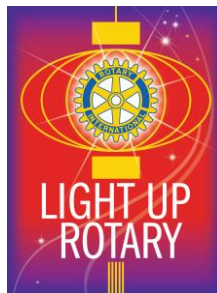

- The main matter at the meeting was a report from a visiting exchange student from France, Odile, who had stayed with a Club member's family for the last 6 months. She was extremely thankful to the family and the Rotary organisation for the opportunity. "How could an organisation do such a great thing?" - Odile described her year in Australia as the best time and most valuable experience she had ever had – she was 'living her dream';
- Odile described coming to the weekly Rotary meeting as like 'coming to a family dinner';
- The Pambula club had more than 50 members from a town of less than 3000;
- At each meeting the club 'toasts' another Rotary club from somewhere in the world. At this meeting, they toasted Port Vila, with the toast made by a member who had researched the club and its activities. A different member prepares the toast each week.
