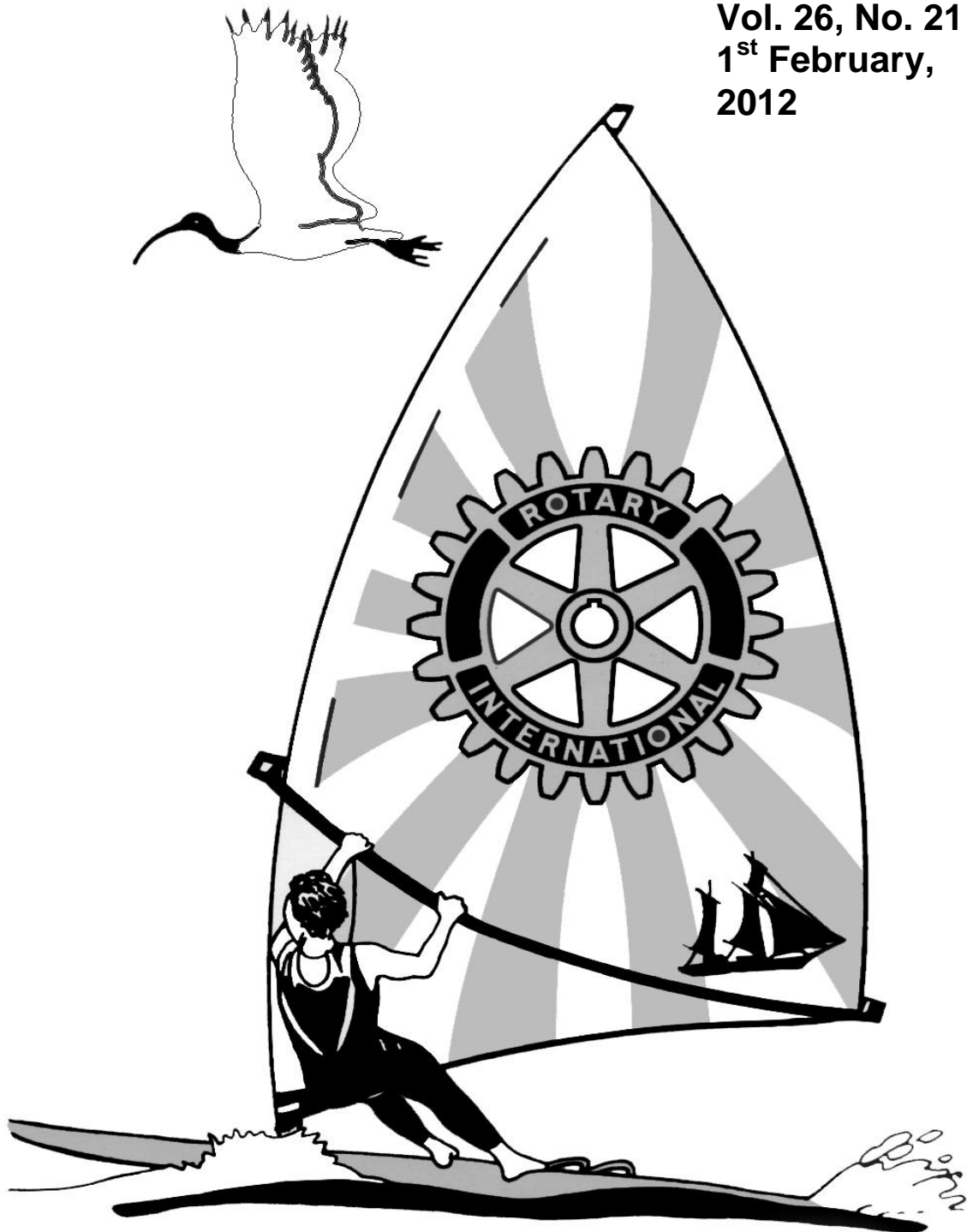

2012 Rotary Boat Raffle



2102 Boat Raffle winner Mark Olden of Cape Woolamai is presented with his prize by Club President Ken Fisher. The raffle raised \$10,000 which will be shared by the Inverloch SES, and Interplast which is a Rotary program which sponsors teams of plastic surgeons to go to developing countries and perform corrective surgery particularly on children to give them a quality of life they wouldn't otherwise be able to have.

Ken Fisher thanked the local community and all the summer visitors who support the raffle each year, the sponsors Inverloch Marine, Rod Bending's Fishing Supplies, Eugenie's, and the Leongatha Golf Club, and all the Rotarians who spent so much time selling tickets, and transporting the boat.

Second Prize of a night for two at Eugenie's of Inverloch was won by Carina Nods of Rowville, and third prize of four rounds of at Leongatha Golf Club was won by 17 months old Will Jenkins of Chelsea Heights.

Boat Raffle Report

Approximately 6,060 tickets were sold, grossing \$18,200. Expenses will be approx \$8,000, leaving \$5,000 each to be distributed to the Inverloch SES which will be used to purchase a rescue winch for their rescue boat, and the Rotary Interplast program. I would like to thank everyone for their cooperation in filling the roster under unusually difficult circumstances, and for their pleasant attitude whilst selling tickets. The public sincerely support the raffle, and it is an iconic part of the Inverloch summer.
